Policy Guidelines for Curriculum 2021

- The Curriculum for all the programme i.e. Civil, Mechanical, Polymer Technology, Electrical, Information Technology, Computer Technology, Electronics and Telecommunication, Automobile Engineering, Dress Designing and Garment Manufacturing and Interior Design and Decoration has been revised and is called as Curriculum-2021. The curriculum for Mechatronics is also implemented from academic year 2021-22.
- The Curriculum is designed on the concept of outcome based Education.
- Industry-Institute-Interaction should be an integral component of curriculum.
- Six months internship (16weeks i.e. one full term) is mandatory to equip the students with practical knowledge and provide them exposure to real time industrial environments.
- Course on Entrepreneurship and Startups to encourage entrepreneurial skills.
- Computer application related courses should be included in each programme.
- Online theory examination for Applied Physics and Applied Chemistry.
- To the extent possible, the weightage of theory and practical (in terms of contact hours) should be balanced.
- Number of Total Credits 120
