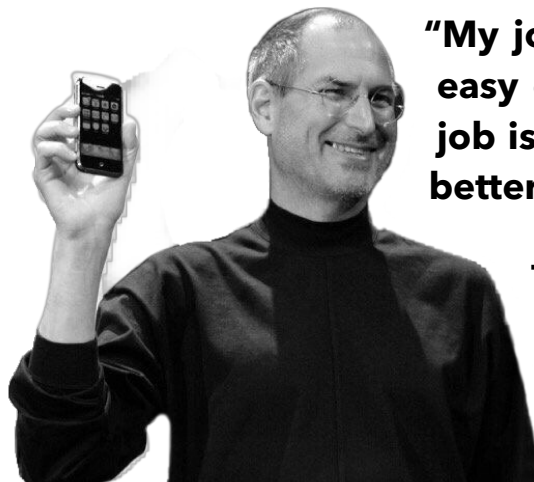

3. Elocution Competition



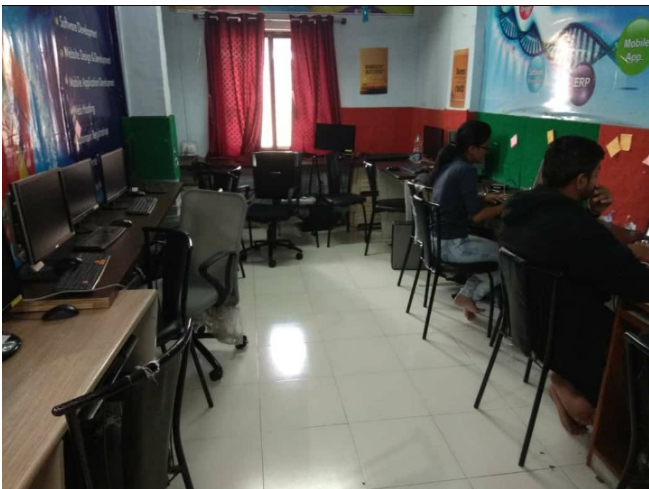
The Event was very much informative and inspirational as it had create a great experience for the students.
