Industrial Visits

Industrial visit is considered as one of the tactical methods of teaching. The main reason behind this, it lets student to know things practically through interaction, working methods and employment practices.

Department of Electrical Engineering has organized an industrial visit to shivananda electronics for 2nd year students. 61 students along with 3 faculties are visited the plant. The visit was very fruitful as students studied various security systems and their working. Also students observed the break test of transformer oil.

Students from Second year electrical visited Indian Railway Traction machine workshop at Nashik road. This workshop gave students practical exposure to DC machine and induction motor internal parts. The winding process and making of squirrel cage rotor were closely observed by students.

Industrial visit of third year electrical students was organized to 33/11 kV substation of mahavitaran at Nashik road. In this visit students got practical exposure to working of isolators and circuit breakers. Also students studies the layouts of substation and working of distribution transformer.





Students from third year electrical visited Huphen electomech pvt. ltd, Nashik. The visit was very much knowledgeable as students got practical exposure manufacturing of current and potential transformer and various types of them. Students also got practical exposure to metering cubide.
